The firm served as lead counsel and secured the denial of class certification in a class action filed against Cingular Wireless in Georgia state court alleging “spam-fax” claims under the federal Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA) and seeking class-wide damages of \$750 million. The trial court’s denial of class certification was affirmed on appeal by the Georgia Court of Appeals. This victory was significant because Georgia had been a leading jurisdiction favoring the certification of class actions under the TCPA. *McGarry v. Cingular Wireless LLC*, 267 Ga. App. 23, 599 S.E.2d 34 (2004).

Represents the American Cancer Society in trademark matters and in opposition and cancellation proceedings before the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board. The firm also provides counseling regarding international and domestic clearance and brand management, licensing, and domain disputes and acquisitions.

Another team of firm lawyers is working with the Lawyers Committee on Civil Rights Under Law and in-house lawyers at Citi to advise a nonprofit organization that has designed and will produce green modular housing in Mississippi to replace homes destroyed by Hurricane Katrina. The firm has provided advice in the areas of corporate, tax, intellectual property, construction, environmental, real estate and finance.
