Mr. Allen is actively involved in pro bono work. He works with pro bono clients in a variety of matters, including



immigration work (e.g., U-Visa and asylum cases). He frequently volunteers at legal clinics including at an organization that focuses on serving the local homeless population and another that focuses on serving the local Latino population. In addition to his pro bono work, he also devotes a significant amount of time to his community.

Mr. Allen's experience also includes an externship during law school with the University of Washington Center for Commercialization (now CoMotion) and an internship prior to law school with the in-house patent department in the Portland, Oregon headquarters of an international manufacturer of heavy machinery.
