## Investing in CO2 Technologies

Private Sector Investments in Climate Technologies – Return on Investment and the New 2018 US Tax Credit for Carbon Oxide Capturing Technologies

Our panel will focus on prominent investor groups and funds that have discovered emission negative CO<sub>2</sub>-capturing technologies – an industry that could grow into a trillion dollar market. Surprisingly, the United States is one of the first countries in the world that introduced an enhanced tax credit for carbon capture and sequestration technologies as part of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018. Still, forecasting the profitability of plants that suck carbon oxide out of the air or out of industrial emissions has been challenging. On our panel, investors and carbon capturing companies will discuss their criteria for investments in the technology, or in carbon capturing plants, and whether the new tax credit will help their return on investment.
